

- 1. Three complaints the children of Israel make. Numbers 11-12
- A. Israel complains about general <u>hardships</u> of the trip. Numbers 11:1-3
- B. Israel complains about the **food**. Numbers 11:4-6
- C. Miriam and Aaron complain about Moses being the <u>driver</u>. Numbers 12:1-2
- II. Israel takes a **dangerous** wrong turn
- A. <u>Twelve</u> spies are sent to survey the Promised Land. Numbers 13:1-2
 - 1. <u>Ten</u> conclude "We <u>cannot</u> take the land." Numbers 13:26-29
 - 2. But <u>two</u> conclude, "Because <u>God</u> is with us, we can take the land." Numbers 13:32

- B. The people <u>rebel</u> and refuse to <u>obey</u>. Numbers 14:8-9
 - 1. This "<u>wrong</u> turn" takes place at the <u>edge</u> of the Promised Land
 - 2. God's "heavy-duty" judgment. Numbers 14:28-34

C. Israel's lack of trust in and disobedience to God creates a 40 year <u>detour</u>.

- 1. The <u>children</u> are punished **suffer** for their parents' disobedience.
- 2. They end up where they **began**.
