I. Divide <u>to</u> <u>Restore</u> . (Genesis 11:1-9)

God <u>divides</u> the people to <u>restore</u> <u>His</u> people.

II. God's plan to <u>build</u> a new <u>nation</u> (Genesis 12:1) He chooses <u>two</u> people, <u>Abram</u> and <u>Sarai</u>

God loves to use **ordinary** people in **extraordinary** ways.

- III. God's <u>four</u> <u>fold</u> plan for the new <u>nation</u> (Genesis 12:2-3)
 - 1. God will make you into a **_great**_ nation
 - 2. God will make Abraham's _name_ great
 - 3. God will bless those who bless and cruse those who cruse
 - 4. God will bless all the **nations** of the **world** through you

IV. God <u>renewed</u> his promises to Abram. (Genesis 13:14)Abram <u>believed</u> God (Genesis 15:5-6)

V. Sarai tries to <u>take</u> God's <u>promises</u> into her <u>own</u> hands

VI. To **encourage** them God **changes** their names (Genesis 17:1-5)

Abraham means <u>Father of many</u> Sarah means **Queen**

VII. Then Sarah <u>laughed</u> (Genesis 18:12)

VIII. Then God said, "Take your <u>son</u>, your <u>only</u> son (Genesis 22:2)
