- I. God's new <u>nation</u> was in danger. (Exodus 1:1-7)
 - A. This new nation was in danger from foreign <u>armies</u> and foreign <u>gods</u>.
 - B. This new nation was in danger of <u>losing</u> sight of God's <u>promises</u>.

"Change will come <u>ONLY</u> when the pain of staying the same is greater than the pain of change."

- II. God<u>reveals</u> himself in<u>three</u> ways in the deliverance of his people.
 - A. God reveals his name. Exodus 3:14

"I AM WHO I AM" (Yahweh or Jehovah) means the <u>self-existent</u>one.

B. God reveals his <u>power</u> over the gods of Egypt through the plagues. Exodus 7-13.

C. God reveals his <u>plan</u> in the 10th plague which required the shedding of <u>lamb's blood</u>.

In order for us to be delivered we must have the blood of the lamb over the <u>door post</u> of our <u>soul</u>.

The question is where will we **get** it?
