God loves you and want wants you to choose to love Him back.

God's ultimate passion is to restore relationship!

I. God's new nation was in danger. (Exodus 1:1-7)

A. This new nation was in danger from foreign armies and foreign gods.

B. This new nation was in danger of losing sight of God's promises.

"Change will come ONLY when the pain of staying the same is greater than the pain of change."

II. God reveals himself in three ways in the deliverance of his people.

A. God reveals his name. Exodus 3:14

"I AM WHO I AM" (Yahweh or Jehovah) means the self-existent one.

B. God reveals his power over the gods of Egypt through the plagues. Exodus 7-13.

"By this you will know that I am the LORD...." (Exodus 7:17)

1. Water turned to blood
2. Frogs
3. Gnats
4. Flies
5. Livestock is diseased
6. There are boils
7. Storms
8. Locust
9. Darkness

C. God reveals his plan in the 10<sup>th</sup> plague which required the shedding of lamb's blood.

In order for us to be delivered we must have the blood of the lamb over the door post of our soul.

The question is where will we get it?

John 1:29 "Behold, the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."

1 Corinthians 5:7, "For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed."
